



Evans City/Seven Fields Regional Police
Meeting Minutes
February 15, 2016 (Seven Fields)



Members Present: Jen Sikora, Kim Armstrong, Lee Dyer, Dawn Servello, Dean Zinkhann, Mike Baer, Chief McCombs, Tom Smith, Secretary, Nadine Grabe and Solicitor, Matt Racunas (via phone conference).

Kim Armstrong made a motion to accept the meeting minutes from January 25, 2016. Lee Dyer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kim Armstrong made a motion to approve the payables as presented. Dean Zinkhann seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Tom Smith recommended that the Commission meet with the part-time officer applicant on Friday, February 19th, or Monday, February 22nd in order to move the hiring process along as the department is currently functioning with a few shortfalls. An exact interview time will be determined in the next day or two.

Tom Smith reviewed the bids for the Patrol Unit, in car items. Two quotes were obtained from Witmer Public Safety Group and Duke's Sport Shop, Inc. Lee Dyer asked why the officers could not rotate the AR15 that the department already has between the cars. Chief McCombs explained that he did not want to be the department that sends their officers into any situation without being properly equipped.

Jen Sikora made the motion to purchase the firearms from Duke's Sport Shop, Inc. and the miscellaneous items from Witmer Public Safety Group and also order the breathalyzer directly from the vendor with the combination of these items not to exceed \$8,500.00. Dawn Servello seconded the motion. Lee Dyer opposed, motion carried.

Chief explained that the speed timer has been on South Washington Street in Evans City and will be moved to another location for a few days before it will be moved to a location in Seven Fields.

Lee Dyer had questions regarding the schedule. Tom Smith asked that if this topic is going to be brought up at the meeting, that it be put on the agenda and all commission members be privy to the information being discussed.

Jen Sikora made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:45 p.m. Dean Zinkhann seconded the motion. Motion carried.
