



Evans City/Seven Fields Regional Police  
Commission Meeting Minutes  
May 16, 2022 @ 5:15 p.m. (Seven Fields)

Members Present Dawn Servello, Dean Galitsis, Cheri Deener-Kohan, Dean Zinkhann, Patty Tumminello-Murphy, Sandy Hein, Chief McCombs, Tom Smith, Regional Police Administrator, and Matt Racunas, Solicitor.

Dawn Servello made a motion to approve the January 31, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Patty Tumminello-Murphy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Sandy Hein made a motion to approve the payables (1/22/2022-5/16/2022), as presented at this meeting. Dawn Servello seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Chief McCombs introduced the two newly hired ECSF Regional Police Department part-time police, Officers Logan Brink and Leo Di Cesare. Chief McCombs explained that Officer Brink is three-quarters of the way through his Field Training Officer (FTO) and should be on his own the first week of June. Regional Police Administrator Smith added that Officer Brink is a graduate of Allegheny County Police Academy and has a Bachelor's in Criminology from the Indiana University of PA. Chief McCombs continued with Officer Di Cesare, noting his 20+ years of law enforcement experience. Regional Police Administrator Smith added that Officer Di Cesare is 2 weeks into his FTO, but he can be fast-tracked and be on his own in mid-June. Regional Police Administrator Smith stated that Officer Di Cesare has 2 master's degrees and is also a Criminology and Spanish instructor at Community College of Allegheny County. Dawn Servello made a motion to officially approve the hiring of Officers Brink and Di Cesare. Dean Zinkhann seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Regional Police Administrator Smith requested approval of the ECSF Regional Police Department's Annual Payments which included KS Bank (\$5,003.18), Plate Capture (\$1,200), YCG, Inc. (\$1,494), UPMC Life Solutions (\$202.80), PA Chiefs of Police Assoc. (\$990), Dropbox (\$720), All Traffic Solutions (\$3,000), Central Square (\$2,404.55), and Auto Accenting (\$900). Dawn Servello made a motion to approve the Annual Payments as presented. Sandy Hein seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The Evans City Seven Fields Regional Police Department's Calls for Service for January through April 2022 were reviewed by the Commission Members. Chief McCombs noted year to date there were a total of 247 calls for Evans City Borough and 234 calls in the Borough of Seven Fields. Patty Tumminello-Murphy asked if the Boroughs can get more information on incidents after the investigations have concluded. Chief McCombs explained that the incidents have to go through the judicial system which can take 6-8 months. Adding, police reports are not public records so he cannot provide that information, but someone can go to the courthouse and request the criminal complaint which is a public record.

Dean Zinkhann made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:31 pm. Dawn Servello seconded the motion. Motion carried.
