



Evans City/Seven Fields Regional Police  
Meeting Minutes

June 24, 2019 @ 5:15 p.m. (Seven Fields)

Members Present: Kim Armstrong, Dawn Servello, Lee Dyer, Michael Baer, Dean Zinkhann, Dean Galitsis, Chief McCombs, Tom Smith, Regional Police Administrator, and via phone conference call Matt Racunas, Solicitor.

Kim Armstrong made a motion to approve the May 20, 2019 meeting minutes as presented. Dean Zinkhann seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kim Armstrong made a motion to approve the payables (5/20- 6/21/2019) as presented at this meeting. Dean Galitsis seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The Evans City Seven Fields Calls for Service for May 2019 were reviewed by the Commission Members. There were no questions. Chief McCombs mentioned that due to the volume of incidents from the night of the storm in Evans City on 5/28/19 the incidents were logged in as one event. Also, the new hires, Officers Scalise and Podolec, are now finished with their Field Training. Dawn Servello commented that it was nice to see them both while on duty at the Seven Fields Carnival.

Regional Police Administrator Smith presented Bulletproof Vest Grant Application which if approved would cover 50% of the cost of purchasing new bulletproof vests for the ECSF Regional Police Department. The ECSF Regional Police Department would be responsible for matching the remaining costs (50%) of the total purchase price of the bulletproof vests. Chief McCombs added that the National Institute of Justice recommends that normal wear time for a bulletproof vest is 5 years, and the department is looking purchasing 12 vests. The ECSF Regional Police Department's portion of the cost would be approximately \$5,000. Chief McCombs stated that the announcement for which police departments are awarded the grant funding will take place in 2-3 months. Michael Baer made a motion for the ECSF Regional Police Department to approve the 50% matching of the Bulletproof Vest grant when awarded at the cost of \$5,000. Dawn Servello seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Regional Police Administrator Smith introduced Nick Carusone who is the most recent ECSF Regional Police Department's part-time officer new hire. He will be graduating from the police academy and will take his state test on July 2, 2019. It is anticipated that Nick will start his field training by mid-July 2019.

Kim Armstrong made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:24 pm. Michael Baer seconded the motion. Motion carried.
